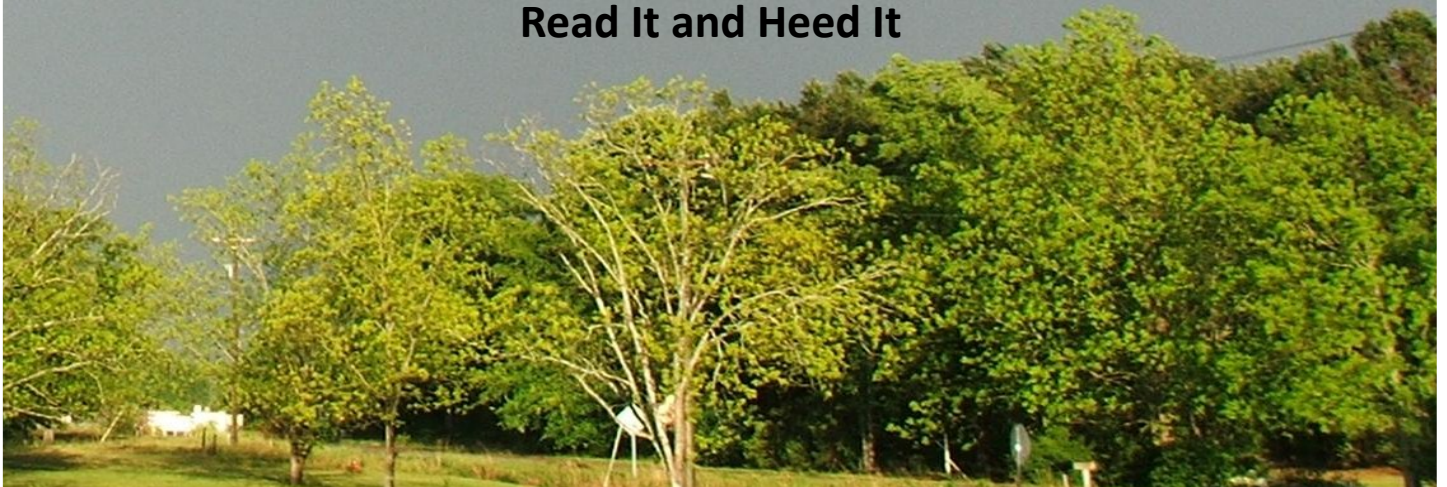
It Is A Message From God
